The awards are focused, curated to bring up talents from DBHEIs. The objective of these awards is to, recognize, appreciate and globalize the talents of DBHEIs.

"BEST ENTREPRENEURIAL INNOVATION AWARD"







- Encourage students to address social problems with innovative business ideas
- Identify potential young entrepreneurs in DBHEIs
- To facilitate the interested students to develop further with appropriate incubation and funding opportunities

PROCESS, CRITERIA



• STAGE 1 – CREATE A VIDEO AND SUBMIT YOUR ENTRY

Students create a two-minute video that showcases their great ideas, highlighting commercial and export potential. The videos are submitted and the interested students register via an online entry form.

• STAGE 2 – SUBMIT A BUSINESS PLAN

Top 50 entries are shortlisted and asked to submit a business plan, choosing at least one for every DBHEI.

• STAGE 3 – FINAL EVALUATION

Ten projects go forward to the final where they present their ideas to the judging panel. This session concludes with the Student Entrepreneur Awards ceremony at the national level during the General Body Meeting of DBHEI in November

Certificates + Cash Prize First Prize = Rs 10,000; Second Prize = Rs 7,500, Third Prize = Rs 5000 Appreciation Prizes = 5 x Rs 1000 = Rs 5000

OBJECTIVE



- Sensitise teachers about the potential of innovative practices and experiments for the improvement of teaching-learning
- Encourage teachers and teacher educators to try out innovative ideas and practices for the improvement of teaching, learning, and evaluation using modern pedagogies and ICT;
- Encourage teachers to identify problems they face in their teaching-learning process and adopt a realistic approach to find their solutions;
- Create an environment in our institutions to ensure sustainability of innovation
- Provide a forum to teachers to share their innovative ideas with all stakeholders.

PROCESS



- Teachers shall submit project proposals in a prescribed format to the Principal who will upload them in the DBHEI Portal latest by 31st September 2021
- The project proposal will be evaluated at the first stage by two experts independently to determine the merit of the proposal
- The project proposals considered to be innovative are forwarded to the Coordinator of the Award Committee.
- Project proposals received by the Award Committee are evaluated by the committee members using the Delphi technique based on the given criteria.
- The teachers whose project proposals are selected shall be informed to implement the project and submit the report along with a summary before the suggested last date

AWARD, REGISTRATION, ELIGIBILITY.



AWARD

The award consists of a cash award of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) and a certificate.

ELIGIBILITY

The nominee should be teaching at Don Bosco higher education institution Minimum one year of teaching experience

"NATIONAL BEST INSTITUTION AWARD"









There is a need to strengthen the roots of democracy, inculcate healthy habits of discipline, tolerance of the view of others, and enable the student community to know about practices and procedures of the Parliament.

- To create awareness about the legislative process among the students.
- To encourage students & motivate them to understand social causes.
- To bring future leaders from the student community.
- To develop the interpersonal skills of the students.

PROCESS



- All DBHEIs are eligible to participate in the 'Portal Based Youth Parliament Programme', having at least 70% of them as students and 30% as faculty members
- Must take up topics which are recommended by the organising committee
- Parliamentarian/ Member of Legislative Assembly/ Eminent political leader /Retired / serving officers including uniformed service officers / Eminent artist /Social Personality / Eminent journalist/writers/ Educationist must be the chief guest to witness the session
- The participants shall speak in English to ensure a common platform for communication
- Each institution shall hold the Youth Parliament sitting on its own premises
- Each Youth Parliament sitting may consist of about 50-55 participants





- The duration of the sitting of the 'Youth Parliament' should not exceed one hour
- The subjects to be selected for discussion in Youth Parliament should be as far as possible noncontroversial. Matters raised in the Youth Parliament may relate to the subjects of welfare activities, defense of the country, social justice, social reforms, economic development, communal harmony, education, govt. welfare schemes, health, student discipline, etc
- No direct or indirect remarks may be made in the speeches so as to cast aspersion on the political parties or leaders/ persons etc. Every year a common theme on Government policies and programs may be fixed for Youth Parliament

REGISTRATION, ELIGIBILITY.



REGISTRATION

- Registration should be done through the DBHEI website with proper details.
- Photos of the event should be uploaded.
- Complete DB-Youth parliament session should be recorded and uploaded in youtube

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Students should not represent any political background.
- 2. Final year students are encouraged to participate.
